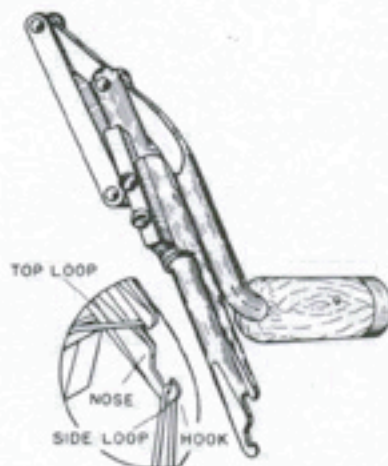


ROCKER

For closing rock fasteners & all-bound boxes & crates

The Rocker is a manual tool used primarily on fruit and vegetable crates. With little practice, an operator can quickly and easily use this tool. While the Rocker is made for a right-handed operator, "left-handed" Rockers are also available for left-handed operators.



DIRECTIONS FOR USE

1. Holding tool as shown (handle down) thread nose of Rocker through top loop and catch side loop in hook.
2. Raise handle away from nose of tool to close lid. This brings top cleat firmly against side cleat.
3. Keeping handle away from nose of tool to maintain tension, swing Rocker down bending side loop over top loop.
4. Lift handle of Rocker, releasing hook from side loop.
5. Press side loop against box. A good closure.
